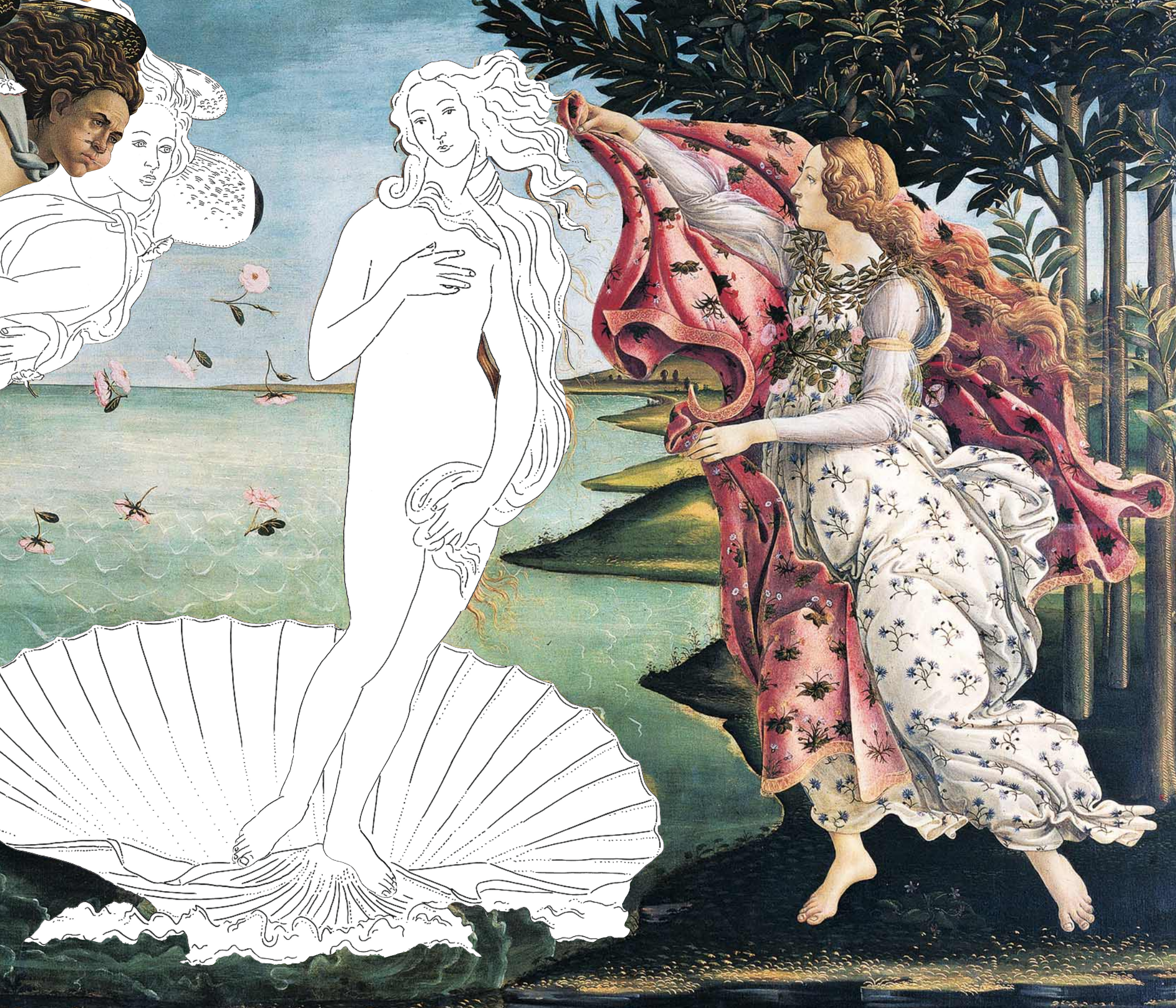


Here the artist has done a self-portrait.

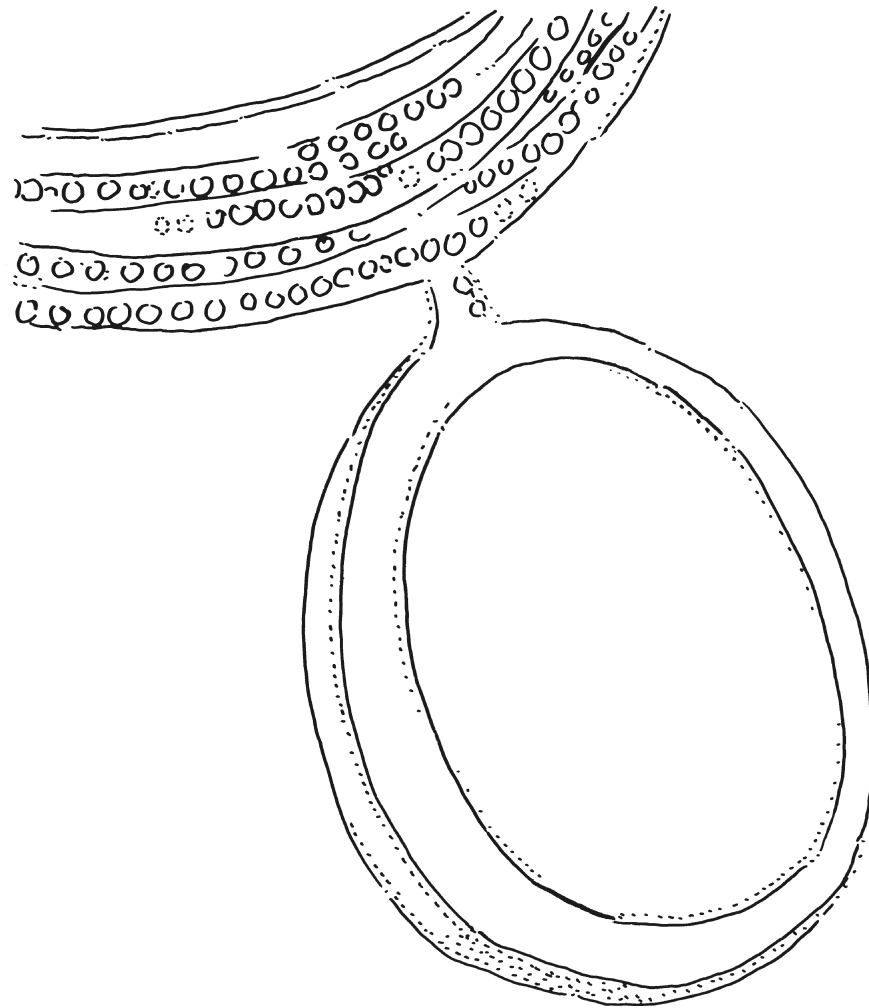




This woman looks truly elegant.

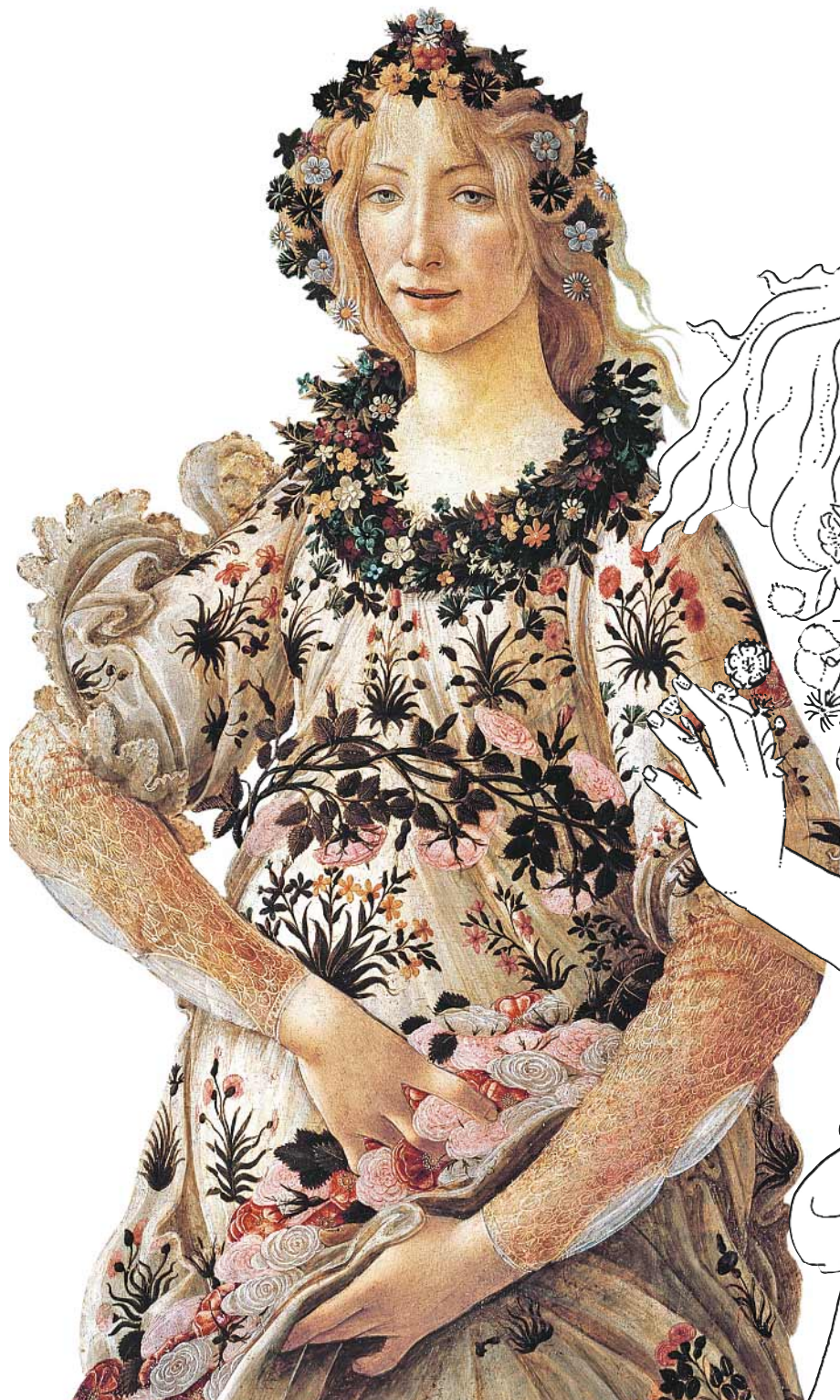


What kind of jewelry should she be wearing?
